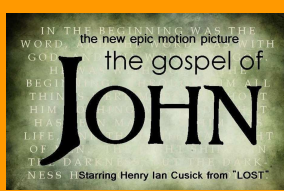
Time Out (7:30pm on 20th) A chill out for women of all ages. Details to be confirmed.

ALISON'S BOOK REVIEW

Total Church : Tim Chester and Steve Timmis

At the Aber Conference I was given this book which has to be one of the most up to date yet reformed and gospel centred work on the church – church being Christ's bride, not our buildings. It starts by challenging our misconceptions of church and showing how, biblically, we are to be gospel-centred and living as Christians under our Lord's reign. "Christians are called to a dual fidelity: fidelity to the core content of the gospel and fidelity to the primary context of a believing community... what we do is always defined by the gospel, and the context is always our belonging in the church".

Each chapter is short and in sections – some even have diagrams!! We are uplifted as Christ's people and challenged as a church to be effective believers not only in our church life, but also in our personal lives which are not to be separated. We are Believers and that defines how we live under the Lordship of Christ. The introduction says "We NEED to be enthusiastic about truth and mission AND we need to be enthusiastic about relationships and community... because people are not sharing their lives, truth is not applied and lived out."

So... order the book at the bookstall, share someone else's, and be prepared to see your role as part of the church in our community and world-wide challenged and changed. I dare you...!!!
